Our Community Day will begin with a time of Meditation according to the John Main tradition.

Les will then speak to us on "MEANINGFUL AGEING", which will include such topics as

- What is it that brings and gives me meaning and purpose?
- "My life is in my hands" - my rings
- Integrity v despair.
- Authenticity and uniqueness.
- Threefold relationship: God, self, others.

After Lunch, there will be a Q&A panel, so please bring along your questions; followed by our Community's News, and another time of Meditation.

Rev Dr Leslie Underwood is a Minister in UnitingSA; and Director of both the Uniting SA Clinical Pastoral Education Centre, and the St Barnabas Anglican Clinical Pastoral Education Centre. Clinical Pastoral Education, or as it is often called C.P. E is education that enables participants to develop themselves personally and professionally as pastoral and spiritual carers for many different settings.
